Willkommen zurück in Deutschland — Welcome back to Germany!

Munich is proud to welcome you back from 17th to 20th of July to the "3rd Munich Open 2014", followed by the Grand Finale of the prestigious "European Backgammon Tour 2013" from 21st to 23rd of July. International backgammon lovers will be able to start their big summer tour in Munich, play or witness the Grand Finale of "EBGT VII", then travel to Cannes, Monte-Carlo and then, to the next WBA-event, the Portuguese Open 2014.

Munich is easy to reach by plane or train and only a short drive from Austria, Switzerland, Italy, Hungary and Czech. Public transport and shuttle busses between the airport and the central railway station are available. Taxi from the central railway station to the hotel is less than 15€

The summer edition of the international Munich tournament will take place in the Vitalis Hotel****, centrally located, right on the border of the Olympic Park, the famous district of Schwabing with countless cafés, bars, restaurants, the "English Garden" and a vibrant nightlife. Public transportation will take you quickly anywhere for sightseeing and/or other activities.

The MUNICH OPEN is a World Backgammon Association (WBA) event, ensuring the highest class of tournaments with the most up-to-date rules, the best professional equipment provided, and the most competitive and challenging format. Every match of the Elite Group division will count for the WBA Point Race ranking list 2014 and the winner being crowned in January 2015 at the German Masters 2015. All Matches of the main event will also count towards the German Ranking List.

Like all other WBA tournaments, all divisions will enjoy the new and improved FT-Swiss Format (out after 3 losses in a Swiss format) and an Ultimate Fight (Last Chance) on Sunday.

Various side-events are lined up: Warm-up, DMP-Challenge, Doubles, Jackpots, Speed-Gammon, etc.

Start making travel plans to compete against your backgammon friends from all over the world and enjoy the beer capital of the world.

General Conditions:

Only cash payments in €uro will be accepted. The WBA tournament rules will apply.

This event is by invitation only, thus the tournament committee and directors reserve the right to refuse application or admittance without giving due reason.

The usage of official tournament precision dice is mandatory. Clocks are mandatory in Elite Group, Doubles and SpeedGammon. Clocks preference in Leisure Group (as far as available). Tournament trophies will be presented during the awards ceremony only.

Leaving the tournament room without informing the Tournament Director and/or staff might result in penalty points and forfeit. Participants must agree when signing up to have their matches videotaped and broadcasted and their pictures and videos being published.

The tournament directors reserve the right to change the program and the distribution of the prize money during the event, based on the number of participants.

Format:

FT-Swiss Format applies in all divisions. Pairings and byes are computerized. A player is out as soon as he loses 3 matches and can still win the tournament with 2 losses. All players not in money in main will play as far as possible the Ultimate Fight (KO Format).

Prize Distribution:

Main event (Elite, based on < 50 players): Main: winner $40\% / 2^{nd}$: $25\% / 3^{nd}$: $15\% / 4^{th}$: 10% - Ultimate Fight winner: 10%

Main event (Leisure, based on < 25 players): Winner 60%, 2nd: 30% - Ultimate Fight winner: 10%

WBA Masters Point Race 2014
